

Following yesterday's announcement by the Chancellor here is a brief overview of the support being offered by the Government. We have still not been given any clear guidance as to how this support will be handled on a practical basis but we are working with colleagues across Greater Manchester and will share information with you as soon as we have it.

- Statutory sick pay relief package for SMEs
- 12 month business rates holiday for all retail, hospitality and leisure businesses
- Small business grant funding of £10k for all businesses in receipt of small business rate relief (this is on properties with a rateable value of £12,000 or less)
- Grant funding of £25k for retail, hospitality and leisure businesses with property with a rateable value between £15,000 and £51,000
- Coronavirus Business Interruption Scheme see <u>https://www.finder.com/uk/business-</u> <u>loans-coronavirus</u>. Bear in mind this is a LOAN and not a grant
- HMRC Time to Pay scheme a dedicated helpline established
