

<u>Please note that **infection levels remain at a high level** and we all need to do our bit to keep people safe. This is the current advice which is due to be reviewed on Thursday, 17 September 2020. Please share as widely as possible.</u>

Rochdale specific measures

- Wear face coverings in shops and all public places, as much as possible
- Keep 2 metres apart, at all times
- Avoid physical contact with anyone outside your own household, including shaking hands or hugging
- Get tested even if you don't have symptoms and isolate if you are told to do so

Government measures

- People from different households are not allowed to meet indoors or in private gardens
- Social gatherings of more than 6 people are banned in any location from Monday, 14 September 2020
- You should try not to share a vehicle with anyone outside your household
- You are only allowed to visit venues such as bars, pubs and restaurants with your own household or support bubble
- You can continue to meet outdoors in public spaces with up to 2 households or 6 people from a number of households but still have to socially distance
